Vaccinations at Solihull Riding Club

Would all riders and competitors please present their horses passport at the office prior to unloading their horse, whether hiring arenas or competing.

Horses whose vaccinations are not within the last 12 months will be refused entry to the site.

RULES

It is a Condition of Entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules hereunder.

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes.

- 1 The Show will be run in accordance with the 2020 NPS Rulebook.
- 2 All stallions and colts two years old and over must hold a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
- 3 All M&M ponies must be registered in their respective stud books and shown as per Breed Society rules.
- 4 The Judge's decision will be final.
- 5 Substitute and nomination entries are not allowed.
- 6 The Show or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from/to any animal, property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the Show or to the conditions or rules prescribed by the Committee thereto.
- 7 Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal, including the spread of infection or contagious disease or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the Show.
- 8 Making entry/entries in the Show shall be deemed to be an acceptance of these conditions.
- 9 Objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary, on the Show Day accompanied by a deposit of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained. All objections shall be delivered to the Secretariat within an hour of the occurrence,/incident otherwise they will not be considered.
- 10 Absolutely no parking on the drive to Solihull Riding Club.
- 11 In the interest of safety, lunging is only permitted in allocated signed areas.
- 12 Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- 13 Members of individual Breed Societies must make themselves aware and abide by the NPS Rules when competing in affiliated classes.
- 14 Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats.
- 15 It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses/ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers/lorries.
- 16 Exhibitors are **not** allowed to set up corrals in the lorry park.
- 17 In the interest of safety, please obey the instructions of the Show Committee or any other Official of the Show at all times.
- 18 In the event of cancellation, a £10 admin fee will be deducted from each Exhibitor. RIHS levies will not be refunded.
- 19 Any person submitting a dishonoured cheque will be subject to a £30 administration fee and will be banned from any future events.
- 20 All ridden stallions must wear a stallion disk while under saddle on the showground.
- 21 All horses and ponies must comply with current BEF vaccination regulations.

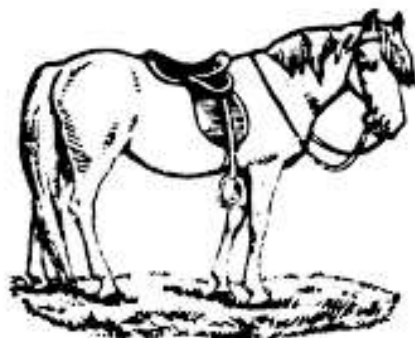

National Pony Society

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **31st July – 2nd August 2020.**

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show **31st July – 2nd August 2020.**

NPS/ASSENDONS Area Final Freestyle to Music: Each Area will nominate a show where the NPS/RINGSIDE STUD M&M Open Ridden Champion and the NPS/KELLYTHORPE STUD Open Ridden Show Pony/ Show Hunter Pony Champion will qualify for the Final, held at the NPS Summer Championships.

The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

If the Champion and/or Reserve Champion have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

British Show Pony Society
