## **‘22 YOUNG JUDGES COMPETITION**

NPS Main Branch will be hosting their annual Young Judges Competition on the afternoon of Monday 1st August 2022 at the start of the Summer Championship Show.

This competition is split into two sections Riding Pony/Hunter Pony (RP/HP) and Mountain & Moorland (M&M), it's divided into 3 age groups under 13, 14-18, and 19-25.

The competition is run on similar lines to the Young Farmers Competitions with the overall winner being given the opportunity to accompany a most prestigious judge whilst they judge the Price Family In-Hand Horse of the Year Show qualifier on Wednesday 3rd August 2022!

Each Area can nominate up to eight potential Young Judges to go forward to the competition. This can be two teams of 4, 1 x RP/HP and 1 x M&M or any combination of up to 8 persons.

As an Area we've had several expressions of interest for 2022, both from those who represented last year and a couple of new ones who have been in touch in response to our Autumn 2021 Newsletter. If you or a member of your family want to get on board, please let me know ASAP.

Preparations for this year's competition are underway. We are having zoom meetings, shadowing judges and ringside discussions at our Area Show on Sunday 22nd May. Plus, 1-2-1's and if viable visits to studs/producer yards dependent on circumstances when expressions of interest and availability of potential Young Judges becomes known.

If you would like to represent Area XI yourself or you wish to nominate someone within your family, and you/they can be available to participate at the Summer Championships then please contact me.

Anyone expressing an interest in being involved in Area XI's preparations will be contacted with further details in due course with full details of our events and join those who have already advised their interest.

If potential Young Judges meet the criteria to represent other Areas, then please contact your own Area Chairman/Secretary for further details.

# RULES

## **It is a Condition of Entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules hereunder.**

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in all affiliated classes.

- 1 The Show will be run in accordance with the 2022 NPS Rulebook.
- 2 All stallions and colts two years old and over must hold a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
- 3 All M&M ponies must be registered in their respective stud books and shown as per Breed Society rules.
- 4 The Judge's decision will be final.
- 5 Substitute and nomination entries are not allowed.
- 6 The Show or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from/to any animal, property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the Show or to the conditions or rules prescribed by the Committee thereto.
- 7 Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal, including the spread of infection or contagious disease or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the Show.
- 8 Making entry/entries in the Show shall be deemed to be an acceptance of these conditions.
- 9 Objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary, on the Show Day accompanied by a deposit of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained. All objections shall be delivered to the Secretariat within an hour of the occurrence,/incident otherwise they will not be considered.
- 10 Absolutely no parking on the drive to Solihull Riding Club.
- 11 In the interest of safety, lunging is only permitted in allocated signed areas.
- 12 Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- 13 Members of individual Breed Societies must make themselves aware and abide by the NPS Rules when competing in affiliated classes.
- 14 Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats.
- 15 It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses/ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers/lorries.
- 16 Exhibitors are **not** allowed to set up corrals in the lorry park.
- 17 In the interest of safety, please obey the instructions of the Show Committee or any other Official of the Show at all times.
- 18 In the event of cancellation, a £10 admin fee will be deducted from each Exhibitor. RIHS levies will not be refunded.
- 19 Any person submitting a dishonoured cheque will be subject to a £30 administration fee and will be banned from any future events.
- 20 All ridden stallions must wear a stallion disk while under saddle on the showground.
- 21 All horses and ponies must comply with current BEF vaccination regulations.

Information will be passed to our printer solely for the purpose of formulating the catalogue. Results information, including photographs may be published (in printed form and online) both to the press, other societies and showing organisations and in the Society's publications. We will not otherwise share your personal data with other third parties without your prior consent unless required to do so by law. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.
