### **NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds**

#### **NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY Affiliation No W11.001**

This Show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Members to enter the Finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2019.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply, (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2018/2019 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2019 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

### **THE NPS/Hy-EQUESTRIAN YOUNG RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP**

Over the Winter season the following classes also carry qualification for the Young Rider Championship held at the Spring Festival.

### **BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY (BSPS)**

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("B.S.P.S."), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

## Important Information

Information from entry forms will be stored on a secure server and the name & address and details of entries will be published in the catalogue (if applicable). Information will be passed to our printer solely for the purpose of formulating the catalogue. Results information, including photographs may be published (in printed form and online) both to the press, other societies and showing organisations and in the Society's publications. Information may be supplied to professional and regulatory bodies as necessary. We will not otherwise share your personal data with other third parties without your prior consent unless required to do so by law. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.

## RULES

- 1 The show will be run in accordance with the 2018 NPS rulebook.
- 2 All stallions and colts two years old and over must hold a current Stallion license, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
- 3 All M & M ponies must be registered in their respective stud books and shown as per Breed Society rules.
- 4 The Judge's decision will be final.
- 5 Substitute and nomination entries are not allowed.
- 6 The show or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from/to any animal, property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or to the conditions or rules prescribed by the committee thereto.
- 7 Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal, including the spread of infection or contagious disease or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her and shall indemnify the show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims damages and expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show.
- 8 Making entry/entries in the Show shall be deemed to be an acceptance of these conditions.
- 9 Objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary, on the Show Day accompanied by a deposit of £50.00, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained. All objections shall be delivered to the Secretariat within an hour of the occurrence/incident otherwise they will not be considered.
- 10 Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- 11 Members of individual Breed Societies must make themselves aware and abide by NPS Rules, when competing in affiliated classes.
- 12 Handlers of ponies in In-Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats.
- 13 It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses/ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers/lorries.
- 14 Exhibitors are **not** allowed to set up corals in the lorry park.
- 15 In the interest of safety please obey the instructions of the Show Committee or any other Official of the Show at all times.
- 16 In the event of cancellation a £10.00 admin fee will be deducted from each exhibitor.
- 17 Any person submitting a dishonoured cheque will be subject to a £30.00 administration fee and may be banned from any future events.
- 18 All Ridden stallions must wear a stallion disk while under saddle on the showground.
- 19 Absolutely **NO PARKING** on the driveway to Barleyfields Equestrian Centre.
- 20 In the interest of safety, lunging is only permitted in allocated signed areas.

### BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE W.H.P./INTERMEDIATE W.H.

Class 3 Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section, (see rule 37). Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cms. Or the Intermediate Section.

### THE NPS/LEYHILLS STUD M&M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Books.

At Foal Shows, the first three ponies in each class will qualify for the Yearling Final at the Spring Festival.

Class 4 Small Breeds, Yearlings, 2 and 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, and Welsh A or B.

Class 5 Small Breeds, 4 years old and over, Stallions, Mares or Gelding. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, and Welsh A or B.

Class 6 Large Breeds, Yearlings, 2 and 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, and Welsh C or D.

Class 7 Large Breeds, 4 years old and over, Stallions, Mares and Gelding. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, and Welsh C or D.

Handler any age, except for stallions or colts when the handler must be 14 years of age or over.

**Championship 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>** prize winners from classes 4 to 7 to compete.

Class 10 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, and Welsh A or B.

Class 11 Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, and Welsh C or D.

**Championship** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 10 to 11 to compete.

## **THE NPS M&M CONFINED NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

Class 13 Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, and Welsh C or D.
